



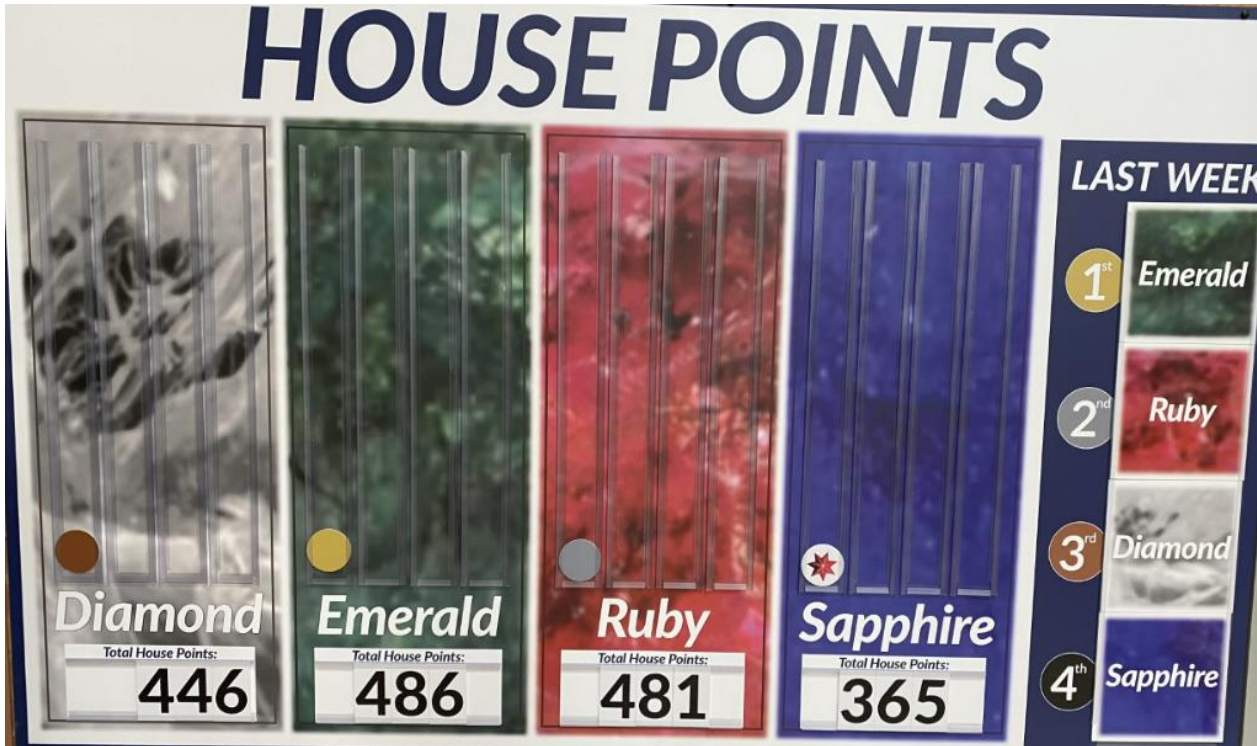
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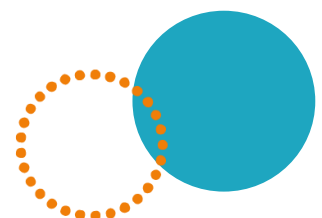

Our children have been amazing gaining so many house points – Well Done to Emerald team who are slightly ahead so far!

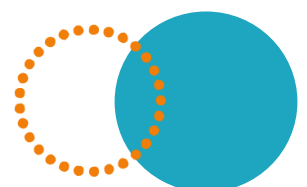
