

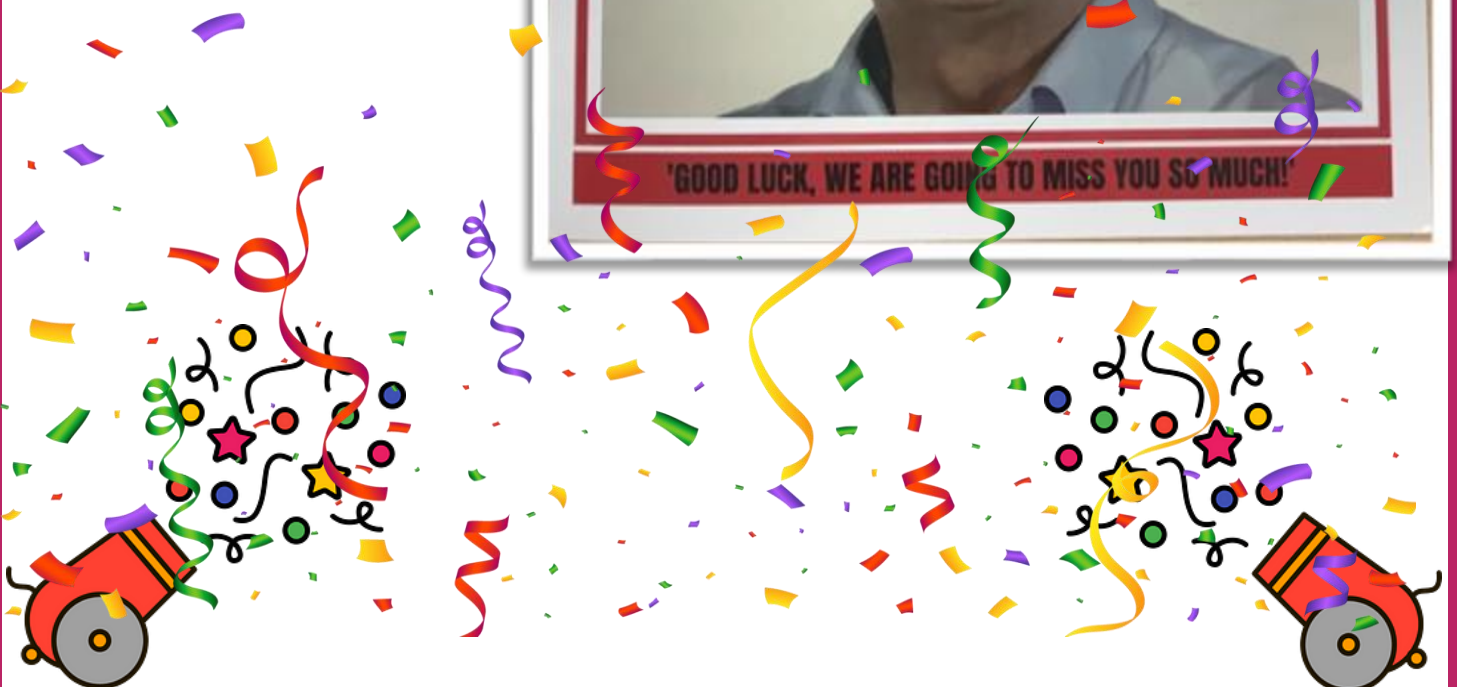


Before half term we held a whole school assembly to say farewell and thank you to Mr Wilson, our Site Manager, who has worked at the school for over 40 years.

Mr Wilson we just want to say a big thank you. Words cannot explain how much you mean to us and how much we will miss you. Enjoy your retirement, you deserve it!



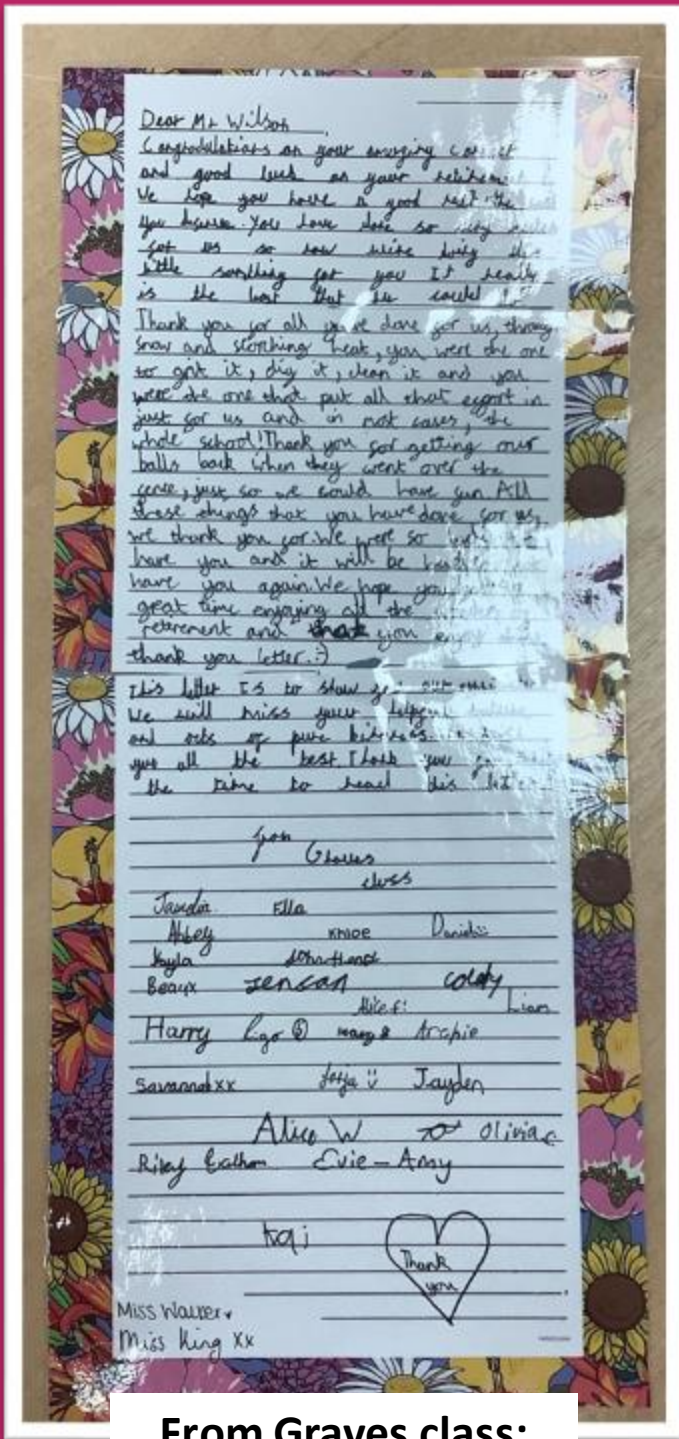

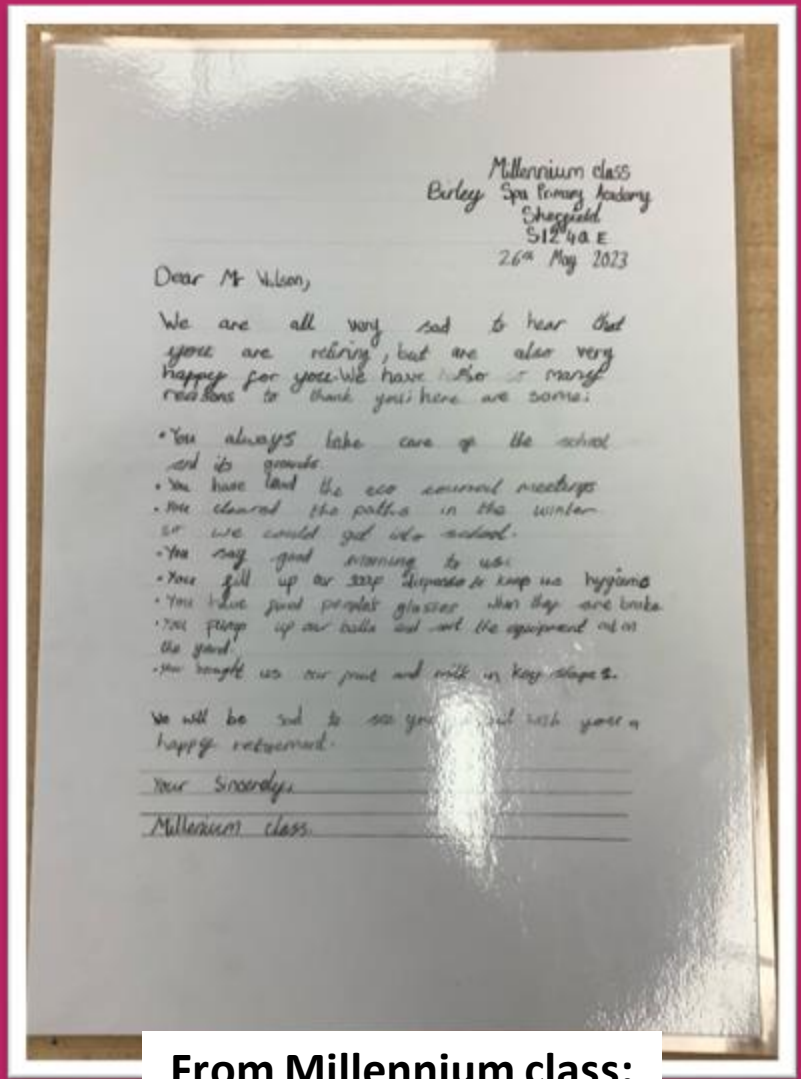

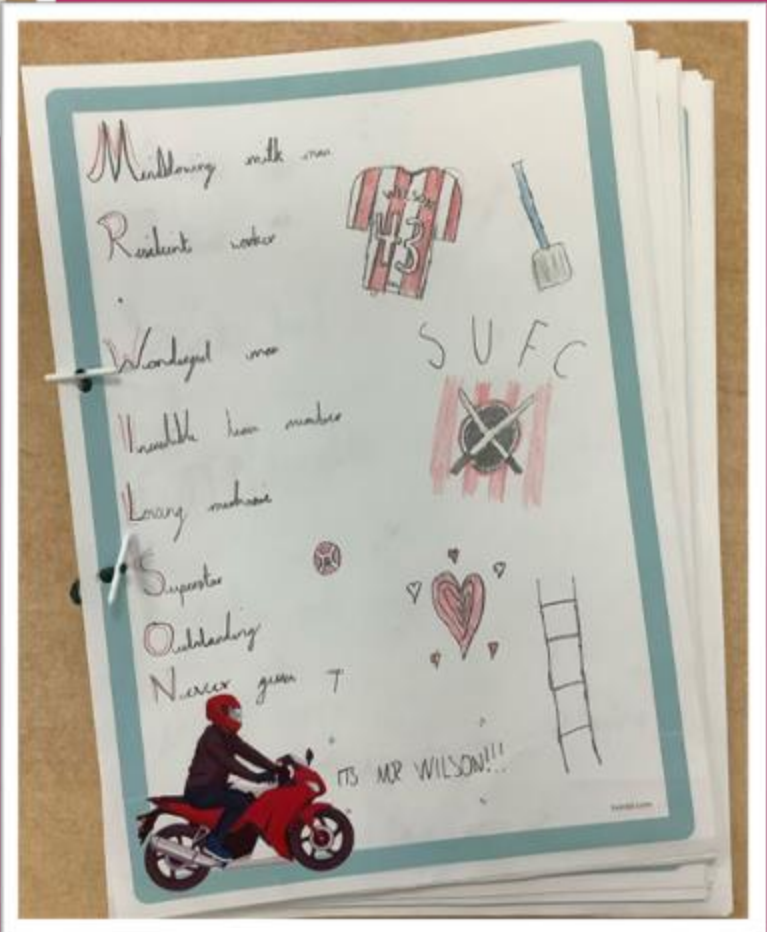
